

LYAMUNGO SINDE

In September 2007 I became a volunteer for Volunteer Services Overseas (VSO) and was stationed in the Kilimanjaro region of Tanzania. My brief, in the education sector, was to

enhance knowledge of and to work with college staff at Marangu Teachers Training College in the use of ICT for teaching and learning. While there I was introduced to village life in Lyamungo Sinde, a village in the Machame district. The village is typical of those in the foothills of the mountain, with subsistence agriculture in family small-holdings as the mainstay of the community.

THE SCHOOL

There is a government primary school in the village. It is



situated next to the church. Primary education is compulsory in Tanzania and most village children attend. The school is made up of 2 buildings, as seen in the picture here with classes from Standard 1 through to Standard 7. The school has a population of 214 children of whom 29 are orphans.

THE PROPOSAL

The purpose of this proposal is to bring attention to the village and the struggles of its people. The village orphans are fostered

on an informal basis within the community often with extended families or by philanthropic neighbours. I would like to establish a support network involving the village committee and perhaps several donors to help the orphans in the village primary schools. With a support network in place the village committee will be able to advance school fees, uniform expenses and stationery for the orphans and manage the resources available for the families. Those currently caring for the orphans are barely able to support their own children let alone their orphaned nieces, nephews or former neighbors' children. Part of this support network will involve ABCDreams (UK) - a recently recognized by HMRC as a charity working in association with ABCDreams (Canada).

THE HELP SO FAR...

The Lutheran congregation supports many of the requirements of the orphans and Otherwise Vulnerable Children but it falls short of the dire need in the community. Carers are struggling with their responsibilities.
